

NO.2011/SAFTY-I/3/11 (.) A SPATE OF ACCIDENTS INVOLVING PASSENGER CARRYING TRAINS HAVE OCCURRED IN THE RECENT PAST CAUSING LOSS OF HUMAN LIVES (.) SAFETY IN TRAIN OPERATIONS HAS TO BE GIVEN TOP MOST PRIORITY (.) WHILE THE ATTENTION HAS TO BE ON ALL AREAS AFFECTING SAFETY, THE FOLLOWING MAY BE SPECIALLY FOCUSED :

- I) WELD FAILURES AND RAIL FRACTURES
- II) MONITORING THE FUNCTIONING OF VCD IN LOCOS
- III) INSPECTION OF PIT LINES HAVING PRIMARY AND SECONDARY MAINTENANCE OF HIGH SPEED TRAINS
- IV) WORKING OF PANELS AT STATIONS DURING EMERGENCY
- V) OBSERVANCE OF RULES BY TRAFFIC STAFF
- VI) PREVENTION OF CASES OF SIGNAL PASSING AT DANGER
- VII) MONITORING FOLLOW UP DAR ACTION OF ACCIDENT INQUIRY REPORTS AS PER LAID DOWN NORMS AND TIME SCHEDULES

IMPERATIVE THAT GENERAL MANAGERS SHOULD PERSONALLY INVOLVE THEMSELVES ON SAFETY RELATED ISSUES (.) FEEDBACK ON ACTION TAKEN BE ADVISED TO BOARD (.)
