



NO. 2011/SAFETY-I/3/9 (.) SEVERAL INSTANCES OF TREES FALLING ON THE TRACKS DUE TO WIND STORMS IN THE RECENT PAST HAVE COME TO THE NOTICE OF THE BOARD. THESE HAVE RESULTED IN OHE BREAK DOWNS AND CONSEQUENT DISRUPTION TO TRAFFIC. INSTRUCTIONS ALREADY EXIST REGARDING PRECAUTIONS TO BE OBSERVED AND ACTION TO BE TAKEN BY ENGINEERING AND ELECTRICAL(TRD) DEPARTMENTS FOR CUTTING/TRIMMING OF TREES LIKELY TO INFRINGE RAILWAY TRACKS. THESE SHOULD BE SCRUPULOUSLY FOLLOWED BY ALL ZONAL RAILWAYS. A FIFTEEN DAY DRIVE MAY BE LAUNCHED IN THIS REGARD BY ALL ZONAL RAILWAYS. CSOS SHALL MONITOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS AND REPORT COMPLIANCE.
